Places may be reserved on the registration form at € 50 per person (incl. transfer).

How to get to Bodrum? The symposium venue is about 45 kilometres from the international airport Milas/Bodrum. There are daily flights of Turkish Airlines (THY) and Turkish charter airlines from Istanbul to Bodrum, moreover there are direct charter flights from most international airports in Europe. Other nearby airports are Izmir and Dalaman. Transfers to and from Bodrum airport can be arranged at € 70 per person, prices for other airports are given on request.

Climate May in Bodrum is typically pleasant with temperatures from an average daytime high of 24 degrees Celsius to an overnight low of 14 degrees Celsius. Generally, there is a 95% probability of sun and 5% probability of rain.
